SUMMARY FILE 1 RELEASED

The United States Bureau of the Census released Summary File (SF) 1 for Oklahoma on July 25. This is the first of four major demographic, social and economic releases from Census 2000. SF1 contains demographic variables such as age, sex, race, relationship, household type, and housing occupancy.

Many of the tables will be available for census geographies from state level to census blocks (the smallest available). Selected tables will be available only

down to census tracts. New to the 2000 Census are data items available for Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs). These pieces are derived from but not exactly the same as U.S. Postal Zip Codes.

The Oklahoma State Data Center will make available one page and multiple page profiles. These profiles will be located on the OSDC web site for the larger geographies while the smaller geographies will be available on request.
